How can we facilitate and accelerate societal transformation? And how can we really bring in diverse allies to drive systemic change? This course helps you find answers to such questions by combining state-of-the-art research with deep critical reflection and applied action learning. We provide a diversity of perspectives that help you discover what works for you.

Special attention is given to tools and methods with which you can organize a process of transition in your area, organization or sector. We are explicitly looking for a diverse, global group of participants, with different backgrounds and experiences. Maybe you have your own business, are keen to create change within your company or governmental organization or would like to bring system thinking to your NGO or academic practice.
